Double/Pass Inversion after our 1♣ opening bid, positive response and competition above 3♥ or in GF situations
Important Notes that don't fit elsewhere
Frequent Upgrades! Weak Opening bids
Frequent TRF-bids after interference (after 1♣ opening)
Bluffs: rare (~1/200 hands), no discussed auctions
